4.0 Public transport services (bus)

Weurtseweg

- 4.1 5.1.20 Is there a bus stop located at the Weurtseweg? 5.1.20 A bus stop is located near the lock.
- 4.2 Is it possible for Hermes to remove the Weurtseweg temporarily out of their route?

 this will cause issues for Hermes. They will not be able to provide their service on the level as it should be. Delays will most certainly become an issue. If we have a date and time two days in advance the situation will be manageable for us.

Questions/remarks

- 4.4 5.1.2e Is it possible to let busses use the Weurtsweweg until 15 minutes prior to blow down?

 No, this will complicate matters and potentially disrupt the blow down.
- How many busses use the Weurtseweg per hour? 5129: depending on time and day 8 to 12 busses per hour use the Weurtseweg. 5129: this seems unmanageable for allowing busses to pass the road closure. 5120: If the event only lasts for 1.5 2.0 hours we take an alternative route.
